

# QUEST POS

## WEEE Compliance Statement

The following policy was drafted on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2015 and will be reviewed annually thereafter.

### Background

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013 apply to all Electrical and Electronic equipment placed on the market in the UK from 1st January 2014.

There are several obligations imposed on Quest POS as a producer of electrical and electronic equipment and these obligations are detailed below.

### Design

Quest POS products are designed to ensure that all of our components can be dismantled and the components and materials are recoverable.

### WEEE Marking

All of Quest POS products that are subject to the WEEE directive shipped from 13th August 2005 are compliant with the WEEE marking requirement. Such products are marked with the crossed-out wheelie bin WEEE symbol in accordance with EU Standard EN50419. This appears on the actual product or in the instance where the product is too small to feature this, it appears on the packaging of the product



### WEEE from users other than Private Households

For products that have reached the end of their shelf life, Quest POS will ensure the recycling of waste resulting from those products arising at the customer's location within the United Kingdom.

The costs of recycling described above are included in the product price as standard. The costs of collecting such waste from customers' premises are not included in Quest's standard offer. However, Quest can provide a chargeable collection service or addresses where customers can return their products. All returns must be issued with a returns reference beforehand.
